For example, Data Protection, Information Security, the Freedom of Information Act and FSA regulations, and many other industry and UK-specific laws require companies to take additional steps to protect customer information.

Security

US businesses lost more than \$7 billion to corporate espionage in 2004 and the UK market is starting to suffer comparative levels of this type of crime with current figures estimated at £1.3billion. A key driver is the volume of strategic information that goes into the rubbish bin every day: business plans, marketing and product plans, price lists, customer lists, legal documents, contracts, payroll records, ID badges, and much more. Similarly, companies must also safeguard employee information such as performance reviews, salary plans, insurance and disability records.

Safe, secure off-site shredding

Iron Mountain's shredding service is the safe, convenient solution for secure disposal of confidential or sensitive information. Disposal teams collect confidential materials in specially designed security containers on a regularly scheduled basis.

Materials are then securely transferred to the nearest shredding plant. All materials, whether stapled, paper clipped, or bound, are securely and completely destroyed using premium, industrial grade shredders and pulverisers. Non-paper materials such as binders, folders, transparencies, films, microfilms, X-rays, photographs, blueprints, credit cards, computer disks, tapes, videos, CDs, and cartridges can also be processed.

Iron Mountain provides accountability receipts for each service performed as well as a Certificate of Destruction with each invoice. Where possible, materials are then recycled.

Document purges

If you're moving offices or clearing out archives, Iron Mountain can provide secure shredding off-site.
